In heraldry, common colours have diverse names. Or and argent are equivalent to gold and silver. Gules and azure are equivalent to red and blue, while vert and purpure stand for green and purple. Sable is the same as black, orange is equivalent to tenne (tawny) and sanguine (murray) is the same as maroon. Gold is indicative of prominent thought and liberality. Silver and white signify sincerity and tranquillity. Red has figurative meanings of power and generosity. Blue is a token of allegiance and honesty. Green is indicative of faithfulness in love and also fulfilment and desire -- excellent sentiments for any type wedding! Purple is emblematic of royalty, of course, but it also stands for justice and dominion. Orange is emblematic of worthy ambition. Isn't it your target to have a lengthy and cheerful marriage? Lastly, maroon is related with the notion of victory. Stay clear of black simply because it has several bad denotations.

For an classy, understated appearance, decide on a strand of radiant ivory pearls to place around your wrist. An extender chain guarantees a great fit and finishes in a tiny, sweet, single pearl which dangles very slightly. Yet another design includes shimmering transparent Swarovski crystals, diamante roundels and also classy ivory pearls in a striking arrangement that blends the crystals with the roundels and spotlights the pearls. A third bracelet is designed with ivory freshwater pearls with a reserved sterling silver heart charm to emblemise your love.
