Diamond carat weight is included amongst the [4 Cs](#) diamond certifying criterion and is also regarded as an integral part of the process of assessing a particular jewel's price. Carat weight is essentially completely separate from the other three diamond grading features which means that cut, clarity in addition to color don't have any influence upon the impact that carat weight has on price and vice versa.

The meaning of carat weight

Carat weight is basically the exact weight of a certain diamond and is essentially a unit of measurement much comparable to a unit like liters which can be used to measure liquids. The proven fact that 0.2 gram has been considered to be equal to a single carat basically points towards the simple fact that a single carat diamond has a weight of 0.2 grams. Therefore, while comparing two particular diamonds, the more expensive jewel will be the one that has a higher carat value. However, customers have a tendency to get confused by the form of a diamond because in some cases, a particular diamond might have a smaller carat weight value but could be much larger than the other diamond in terms of its size. The impact that the shape or cut of a diamond has got upon its apparent dimensions can be grasped by understanding the term referred to as diameter of a diamond's table. A diamond with a larger sized table diameter when compared with another diamond might look larger but might also possess a small carat weight valuation which would make it cheaper than another smaller looking diamond. In the same way, the [cut](#) of a diamond can make a jewel look bigger or smaller thereby permitting larger looking diamonds (small carat weight values) to be cheaper than smaller looking ones (larger carat weight values).

Thus, the actual carat weight characteristic is really a totally different platform for measuring the worth of a diamond and should not be combined with other features. But don't confuse karats with carats since the former is used in conjunction with calibrating gold whilst the second is distinctly employed for diamonds.

However, if carat weight is your only selection criteria then it's smart to opt for smaller diamonds. While on the other hand, moving from a 2 carat diamond to a 3 carat one will lead you towards shelling out an additional hundreds and hundreds of dollars. However, the monetary distinction between a 1/2 carat jewel plus a 1 carat jewel is nothing in comparison to the difference between a 2 and a 3 carat diamond. Thus, a single carat jewel is more or less the ideal choice for any normal diamond hunting consumer.

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
