To bring to mind this magical feeling, pick an illusion necklace in which ivory Swarovski pearls and sparkling Swarovski crystals appear to float about your neck. One more necklace to take into account is a pattern which has a gorgeous and delicate sterling silver chain that has a luminous ivory freshwater pearl and moonstone droplet. Moonstone is a mysterious natural gemstone which has an unmistakable white shimmer that is reminiscent of the light of the moon. Assuming this particular necklace isn't to your liking, why don't you take into account a gorgeous necklace consisting of circular, glowing ivory freshwater pearls interspersed with sparkling clear Swarovski crystals.
