Color. The color of the stone has a great effect on its price. Sometimes this is referred to as the color value of the diamond. You could ask the jeweler to arrange the diamonds of your choice based on color value. It might be hard to see the difference in color because they are so light. Keep in mind the less color the more expensive.

The Diamond's Clarity. Clarity is no less important when it comes to selecting a diamond. An FI (Flawless) graded diamond shows no inclusions (inclusions = flaws) under 10X magnification. Since flawless diamonds are extremely rare, be prepared to pay extra for perfection.

The Cut. This aspect is influenced by humans. The cut is also called the make. The cut's value can be very subjective.

The Carat. Diamonds' weights are measured by the carat. It is connected to the weight of your diamond.

Diamonds come in lots of types. They may all be beautiful, but they have different cut, color, clarity, and carat. Hopefully, this article has been of some help to you in choosing an engagement ring. Take note that you should only buy from a reputable jeweler.
